Open to all Breeds and Mixed Breeds of all sizes.
Trials will be held inside non-heated building on hard-packed gravel.

Classes offered each day:

Instinct Test (Trial 1 only on each day), Novice, Open, Senior, Master
There will be a lunch break at the judges' discretion.

Day-to-day and trial-to-trial move ups available both days.
Move-up must be requested prior to the start of the next trial.

All entries must be accompanied by entry fees and signed release form to be valid.

A returned check does not constitute a valid entry. There is a \$35.00 fee for all returned checks.

EXHIBITOR INFORMATION

Dogs must be registered with Barn Hunt Association to participate.

Dogs may enter any of the offered classes: Instinct, Novice, Open, Senior or Masters Classes. Instinct and Novice may be entered at the same trial. For all other classes, only one class per trial is allowed. **No entries will be taken over the phone.**

First dog in ring at 8:30 am

The run order and further scheduling details will be emailed to all competitors after trial closes and the actual number of entries in each class are known. JBKC reserves the right to change run order based on entries.

Dogs will be run in height order with dogs being handled by the same person separated into different staged groups.

Running/Schedule:

SAT: Small to Large

SUN: Large to Small

HEIGHT DIVISIONS

Dogs 13" and under
Small

Dogs 13.1 to 18"
Medium

Dogs over 18"

AWARDS: Ribbons will be awarded for first through fourth place in Novice, Open, Senior and Master classes in each height division. Ribbons will be awarded for all qualifiers in the regular classes and the Instinct Test. High in Class award will be offered in Novice, Open, Senior and Master classes. Title ribbons will be awarded to all dogs earning a title, upon notification to trial secretary. **Please contact trial secretary if you might be earning your RATCH or RATCHX at this trial.**

Bitches in season are eligible for entry but will be required to be kept separate from all other dogs and will be run in panties at the end of their class/trial. Entry fees for bitches that come into season will be refunded until closing time of the trial if you wish to withdraw. After the trial closes for pre-entries on Sept. 8, 2017, entry fees will not be refunded. *If bringing a bitch in season, please inform the Trial Committee prior to the trial, and you must inform all exhibitors at the judge's briefing.*

REFUNDS: Entry fees will be refunded if requested prior to early entry cut-off date of Sept. 8, 2017. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that the dog is absent, disqualified, excused or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, acts of God, public emergency, and an act of a public enemy or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

DIRECTIONS TO TRIAL SITE:

I-90E/I-39S from the North: Take Janesville Exit 175A, keep right continuing westbound onto E. Racine St. into Janesville. Turn right at second traffic signal onto Randall Avenue. Travel 0.8 miles and turn left onto Craig Avenue, then right into entry gate. Follow signs to trial buildings.

I-90W/I-39N from the South: Take Janesville Exit 175, keep left to take the ramp toward E. Racine St. (westbound). Follow through roundabouts, continuing westbound on E. Racine St. into Janesville. Turn right at second traffic signal onto Randall Avenue. Travel 0.8 miles and turn left onto Craig Avenue, then right into entry gate. Follow signs to trial buildings.

COLLARS and LEASHES: All dogs must be on a short leash and under control while on trial grounds. Approved collars include flat snap or buckle collars of solid construction and leather or nylon leads. Limited slip martingale collars are allowed. Single piece slip collars/leads are allowed. Harnesses, with the exception of head-halter types, are allowed. Dogs MUST run "naked," without a collar/harness. Collars/harnesses that can be easily and quickly removed and replaced are strongly encouraged. **NO flexi-leads allowed.**

Please bring adequate water for you and your dogs.

SMOKING: Smoking is not allowed on the grounds. If you must smoke, you will need to do so inside your vehicle and dispose of the butts in the vehicle also.

LOUD/DISRUPTIVE DOGS: Dogs that are loud and disruptive may be asked to locate away from the rings/crating area and/or staged away from the other dogs getting ready to compete.

Any dog behaving in a threatening or aggressive manner toward another dog or a person may be dismissed from the trial if justification is found by the judge and/or test committee.

Terrier sparring is not allowed on trial grounds.

Any dog that is sick, injured or lame will be excused from the trial grounds.

The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely. Rules can be found at <http://barnhunt.com>

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dog(s) and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dog(s) and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In that case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

CRATING: It is also advisable to bring a crate for your dog during times they may need to be left unattended. Be sure your crate is secure. **No x-pens allowed.**

CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR DOG(S): Dog exercise areas will be marked. A separate bitch-in-season area will be designated. Please pick up after your dog and dispose of waste in appropriate containers in the area. Please be considerate about picking up after your dogs and leaving the grounds as you found them. Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement per BHA regulations.

Rats used at these trials are from a closed colony and are believed to be free of the Seoul virus. Protective gloves will be available for rat wranglers that prefer to wear them.
