Check off the boxes on the entry form for the trials you are entering. If you do not indicate which trial(s) you are entering, your entry will not be processed until corrected. **Make sure you have included both sides/pages of the entry form for each dog.**

EACH OBEDIENCE TRIAL: \$28.00 for first entry of each dog in each trial. (Includes AKC recording/event fee).
Each additional Obedience entry of the same dog is \$22.00.

RALLY TRIAL: \$ 28.00 for the first entry of each dog in each trial (Includes AKC recording/event fee). Each additional Rally entry of the same dog is \$22.00, TRIPLE Q RALLY ENTRY 72.00-(includes the AKC recording/event fee).

Directions to the Show: From the North or South on I90/39: Take exit 177 (Hwy 11 West) to 51, North on 51 about ½ mile. We are on the left next to the Janesville Comfort Shop Parking is in our lot in front or to the North of our building.

Exhibitors please note: A recording fee and event fee will be required of each dog and are included in the entry fees as mentioned above. These fees are to be collected by the show-giving club and paid to the American Kennel Club. Fees are collected on each Rally entry. Rally and Obedience are each separate trials. (American Kennel Club Rule). Only entered dogs are permitted on the grounds. Any dog causing a disturbance must be removed from the ring area. All dogs must be on leash at all times, except when being judged. No exercise pens or grooming allowed. Indoor crating for Rally on Friday, only. No indoor crating on Saturday and Sunday, there is plenty of parking, crate in your car, please. Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

Entries should be typed or printed, except for the proper signature, on Official American Kennel Club entry forms only. Incomplete and/or illegible entries will not be processed. Include only AKC titles on the entry form. Telephone entries, faxed entries and entries sent by a method requiring a signature will not be accepted. Please make checks payable to JBKC. All changes, alterations, cancellations of entries before the closing date must be legible, must include the AKC name and number of the dog, and must include the signature of the owner or his or her duly authorized agent. If, because of weather, riots, civil

disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of JBKC it is impossible to open or complete any of these trials, no refund of entry fees will be made for the affected trial.

A refund of the entry fee less \$5.00 PER ENTRY for an entered bitch that comes in season after entries close will be made upon presentation of a statement by a licensed veterinarian to the Trial Secretary at least one-half hour before judging commences on the day of the trial (Rally and/or Obedience).

FOOD:

Food will not be available for purchase. There are many restaurants within 5 minutes of the show site.

Trial Site Rules

Please exercise dogs in the designated areas. Handlers who do not clean up after their dogs will be excused from the trial without a refund. There is no excuse for not cleaning up, we have a bag dispenser.

Please do not park in front of the other businesses. We have plenty of parking in our lot and north of the building.

AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event, and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of the dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim, and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury, or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. INSTRUCTIONS

1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of a breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).

2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.

4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a show closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any show for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
